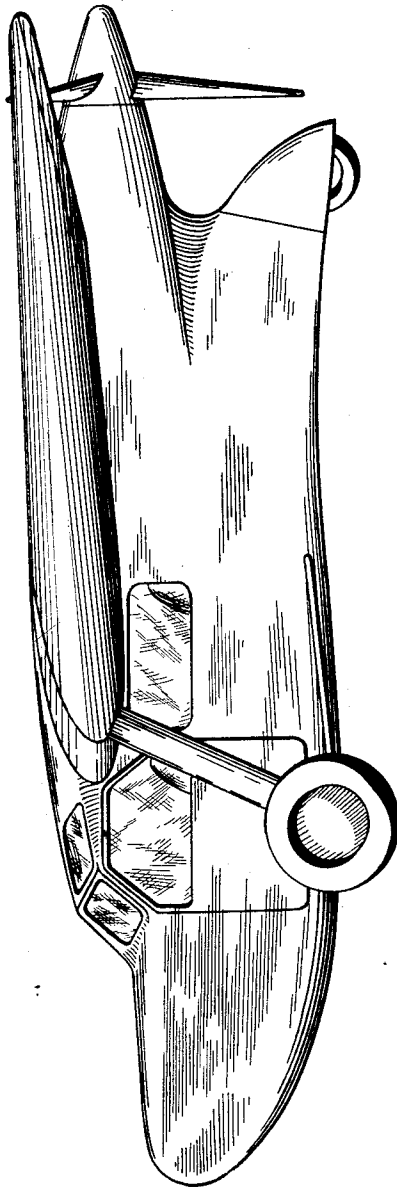

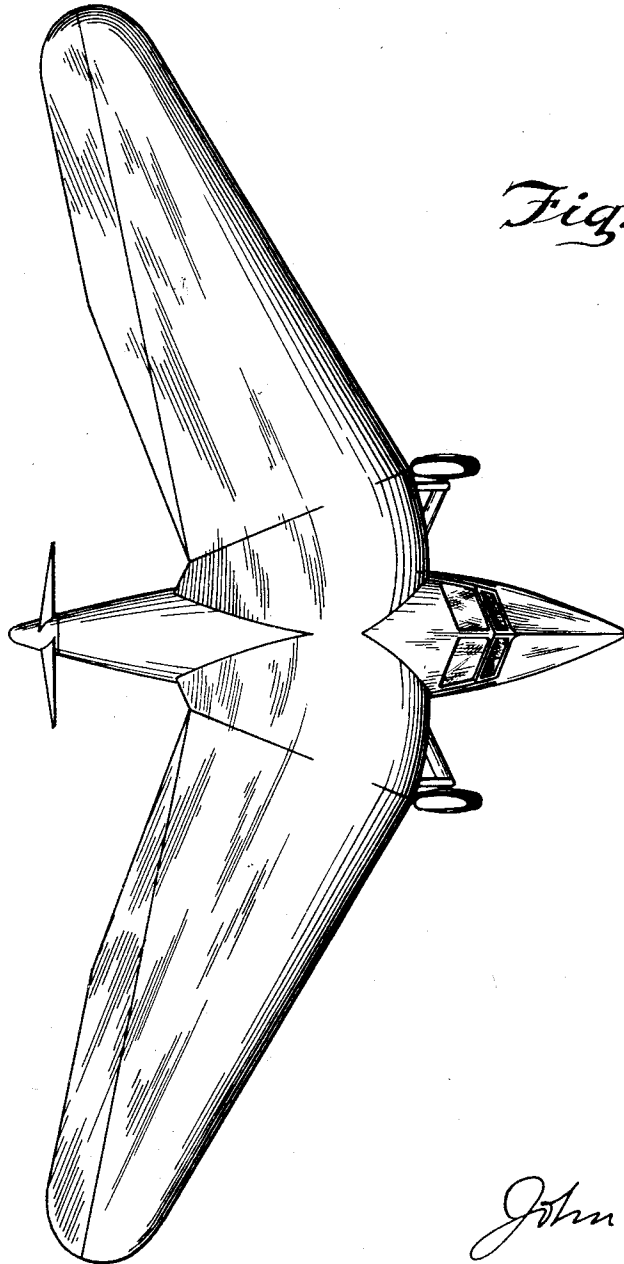

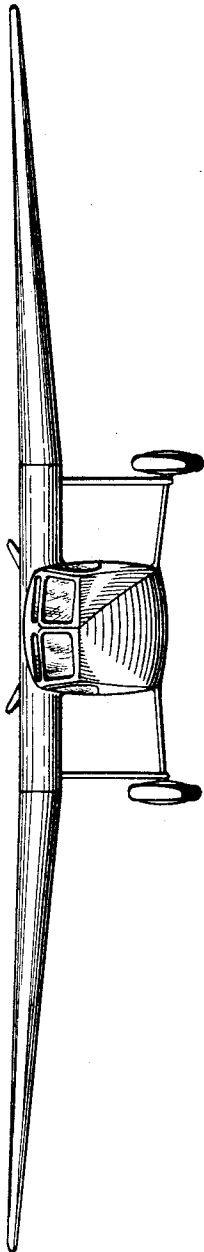

JOHN PAVLECKA AND VLADIMIR HENRY PAVLECKA, OF DETROIT, MICHIGAN

DESIGN FOR AN AIRPLANE

Application filed November 23, 1931. Serial No. 41,833. Term of patent 14 years.

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that we, JOHN PAVLECKA and VLADIMIR HENRY PAVLECKA, citizens, respectively, of the United States of America and of the Republic of Czechoslovakia, residing in Detroit, in the county of Wayne and State of Michigan, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for Airplanes, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawings forming a part thereof.

In the drawings:—

Fig. 1 represents the side view of an airplane showing our new design.

Fig. 2 is the plan view of the airplane in Fig. 1, and Fig. 3 is the front elevation of the same.
